 - do not meet the Work Test in the current the financial year;
 - · met the Work Test last financial year;
 - · had a total superannuation balance of less than \$300,000 at the end of the last financial year;
 - have not used the Work Test Exemption to make contributions in a previous year.

Working for gain or reward can include acting as a director of a company or employment under a labour hire contract but, does not include voluntary work for charity.



Note: The Work Test Exemption can only be used to make voluntary contributions in the financial year you satisfy the exemption criteria. It can't be used again in subsequent years.

¹ If you're aged 74 your last contribution must be received by AustralianSuper within 28 days after the end of the month in which you attain the age 75.
